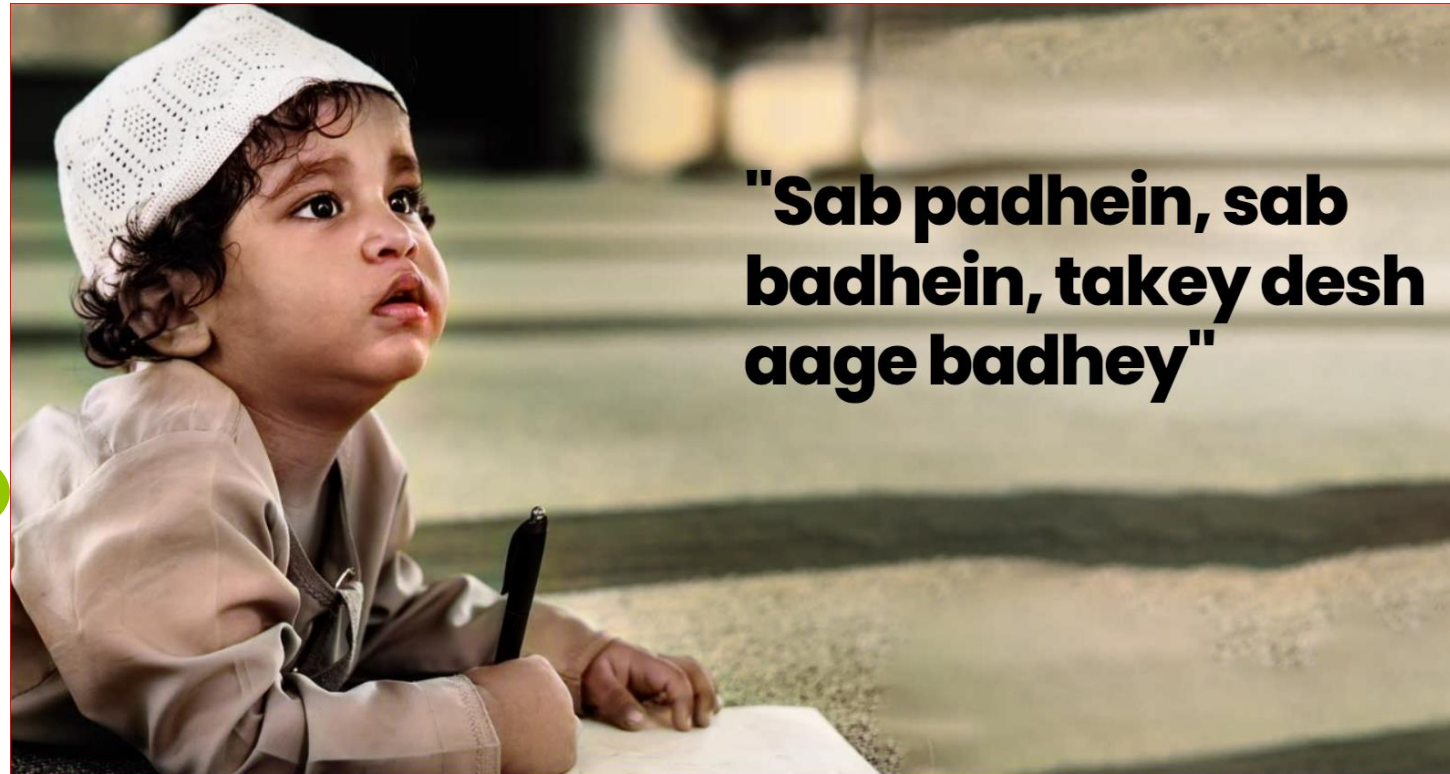

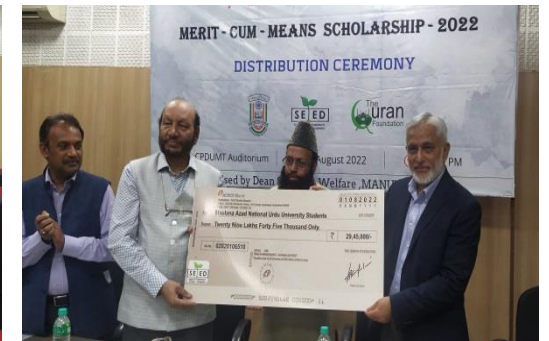

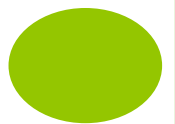
# MOHALLA TUITION CENTER @MASJIDS
